Confirmation of the last minutes held on 31/10/2018.

- (1) **Agenda Item No. 1:** Review of Programme, Course Structure, curriculum and Academic Policy

It was suggested that intake of B.A..LL.B.(Hons.) and B.Com..LL.B. programme should be increased

It was suggested that Civil Procedure Code should be taught in two semesters to give an exposure to the students about the procedural laws.


(2) **Agenda Item No. 2** : Discussion on innovation of Teaching

It was suggested that more emphasis should be given to Clinical Legal Education while framing the course curriculum.

(3) **Agenda Item No. 3** : Any other item with the permission of Chair

It was informed by the Chair that according to the new Bar Council of India (BCI) Rules, 2019, LL.M. is going to be the part of BCI Regulations and as per that regulations they are only going to recognize two year LL.M. Programme for the appointment of the faculty members. So in light of this rules, it was suggested that we need to shift LL.M. programme from one year to two years.
